Current activity in the PIMA Safety Program –

- PIMA would like to review their Strategic Plan. The current plan ends in 2006 and PIMA would like to get input (negative and positive) from the M91-01 Safety Committee.
- Overview of 2004 stats
 - Saskatchewan Priority companies had an estimated \$430,000 in reduced time loss claims.
 - Direct value of training at an estimated \$103,000
- Review of first quarter stats (handout)
- PIMA is currently working on the new Audit Protocol
 - Reviewing standards (BSI 18000)
 - The current Audit document is not as challenging as it should be.
 - We are currently at a level 2 and looking to be a level 3 or 4.
 - PIMA is looking into WCB incentives, insurance company lobbying for “safe company” discounts.
 - Approx a year away from WCB and then PIMA will look at the Insurance Companies.
- Fees
 - Companies not in the M91-01 rate code must be charged for the services they are using.
